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Executive Summary

M&K Global is committed to achieving Net Zero greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions by 2050, in line with UK Government policy.

We recognise our responsibility to minimise our environmental impact and will continue to take steps to reduce emissions across our operations, focusing on business travel, office energy consumption, and digital infrastructure.

1 Baseline Emissions Footprint

Our baseline year is 2023. This is because our first two subsidiaries were founded in 2023 in Berlin, Germany, and Bern, Switzerland, and the company began hiring full-time employees rather than external subcontractors.

As a professional consultancy, our emissions are primarily associated with:

- Office electricity and heating (Scope 2).
- Business travel (Scope 3 – air and land transport).
- IT services and equipment (Scope 3 – purchased goods and services).

Estimated Emissions Baseline (2023):

- Scope 1 (Direct emissions): 0 tCO₂e (no owned vehicles, no fuel combustion).
- Scope 2 (Purchased energy): 0.8 tCO₂e (office energy use – estimated).
 - The offices referenced are in Berlin, Germany, and Bern, Switzerland.
 - Please note that these office spaces were not full offices owned by the company, but were spaces in coworking offices at the time.
- Scope 3 (Relevant categories).
 - Business travel: 4 tCO₂e.
 - Travel was limited, and rail travel was preferred over air travel.
 - IT services/cloud infrastructure: 2 tCO₂e.
 - Waste & commuting: 0.8 tCO₂e.

Total baseline emissions (2023): ~7.6 tCO₂e.

2 Current Emissions Reporting

Our current reporting year (2024) is in line with the baseline.

As M&K Global AG is a small enterprise with turnover well below the £36 million threshold, we are not legally required to publish a Carbon Reduction Plan on our website under the Procurement Policy Note (PPN) 06/21. However, while public disclosure is not mandatory for an organisation of our size, we have developed a CRP to demonstrate our commitment to reducing greenhouse gas emissions and achieving Net Zero by 2050, which aligns with UK Government policy.

M&K Global AG are happy to provide updated information upon request.

3 Emissions Reduction Targets

Murzilli Consulting commits to the following trajectory:

- 20% reduction in Scope 1 & 2 emissions by 2030 (through green energy, reduced office footprint, energy efficiency and climate-positive activities).
- 15% reduction in Scope 3 travel emissions by 2030 (through lower-carbon transport choices, or any other carbon offset mitigations).
- Net Zero by 2050 (aligned to UK Government targets).

Progress will be monitored annually and published as part of this Carbon Reduction Plan.

4 Carbon Reduction Measures in Progress

We have already implemented, or plan to implement, the following:

- Encouragement of low-carbon travel (train over plane, EV/hybrid hire).
- Use of energy-efficient IT equipment and responsible recycling of hardware.
- Our Spanish entity (M&K UAS & SPACE SPAIN, S.L) has achieved ISO 9001 certification for quality management, demonstrating our commitment to internationally recognised continuous improvement standards. These processes support our ability to track, manage, and report on sustainability performance alongside operational delivery.

5 Validity and Approval

This Carbon Reduction Plan has been reviewed and approved by senior leadership of Murzilli Consulting.

Our integrated management approach, supported by ISO 9001 certification, ensures that our commitments to quality, sustainability, and carbon reduction are embedded across the organisation.

We confirm that the information provided is accurate and that our organisation is committed to achieving Net Zero by 2050, which aligns with UK Government requirements.
